During this phase of the pandemic, while most cinema and studio photography is shut down, Chimera has re-purposed some of its manufacturing capacity to build reusable cloth face masks.

The masks are made of 2-layer fabric and currently available in two versions; one with a poplin exterior layer in assorted colors and one with a gray Nylon/Spandex exterior. Both have a soft, acrylic fabric interior and are intended for reuse after

laundrying. These masks can be worn alone, or as extra protection over an N95 mask to extend its life when there's a severe shortage of PPE.
